What is a NAS?

A NAS is Network Attached Storage – a mini Server that holds data to be shared over a network.

The NAS responds to requests for information from other computers: it "serves" files, data, print, applications, and more to multiple computers on the same network.

An appropriately configured NAS can offer:

- File and Network security – manage users, computers, passwords, data access, encryption, etc.
- Increased reliability – built with quality components to ensure high availability & security of your data.
- Centralised Backup – allowing you to retrieve accidentally deleted files and restore previous versions.
- Centralised data storage and shared resources. Providing one central place to store business information, meaning you can better manage business-critical information. It's easier for staff to find, access, and securely share information.
- Give older PCs a new lease of life – by off-loading their files and data onto a NAS, older PCs work more quickly and effectively – with less chance for data loss!
- A NAS offers a more cost effective solution than traditional Server based technologies.
